## Budget Shortfall

The City of Longview is experiencing some of the same losses of revenue that are occurring throughout the country. The biggest immediate challenge for the City is the decline in our sales and use tax receipts. This will create a projected budget shortfall of about \$1.5 million this year unless we take other steps quickly. This trend will probably continue through 2009 and possibly into 2010.

## Cost-saving Measures

The City Manager has already announced several measures to control and reduce spending, including no new merit step salary increases for employees, no cost-of-living salary increases for 2010, limiting travel, extending vehicle replacement cycles, and not filling vacancies in positions as they occur.

## City Offices Closure Schedule

One additional cost savings effort that will begin this month will be employees taking one unpaid “furlough day” per month. Most office closures will occur on a Friday, but a few will be on alternate days. Please take note of the following closures:
