

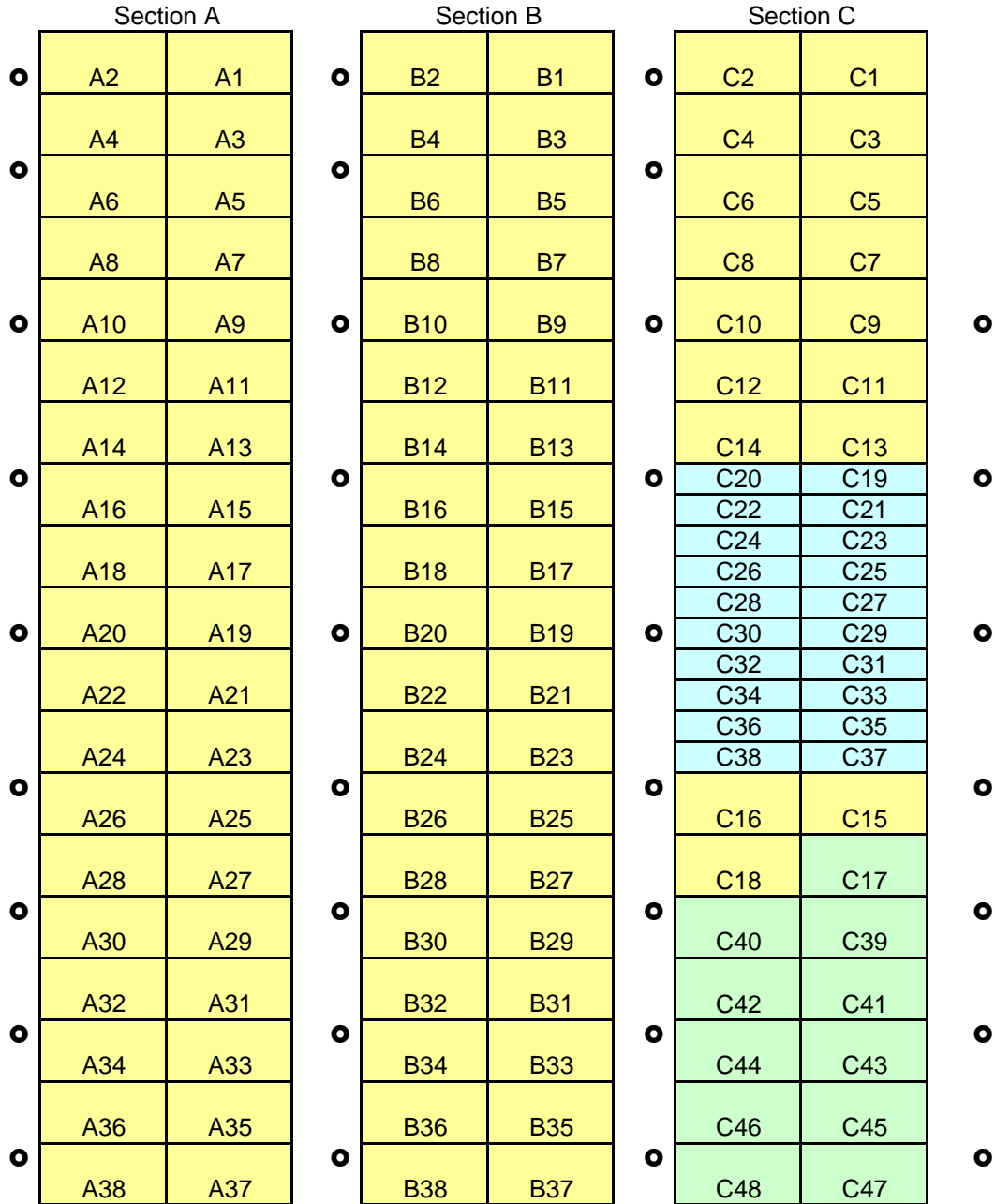
Community Garden Rules & Regulations

- Garden spaces are for producing crops and plants for personal use. They are not to be used for producing crops that will be sold for monetary gain.
- Gardeners may only use the 20' x 40' (10 feet left & 10 feet right of numbered space marker) or 10' x 20' (5 feet left, 5 feet right of numbered space marker) space assigned to them.
- All non-planted areas of the space must be weed free. If for any reason you cannot care for your garden, you must make arrangements to have your space maintained.
- Space maintenance is the responsibility of each gardener. Gardeners should endeavor to keep borders free of weeds and other materials that may impact neighboring gardens.
- Garden spaces will be rotor-tilled & marked by Parks & Recreation when weather permits, (usually around the first part of May) at which time you may prepare and plant.
- Water is furnished, but gardeners are to provide their own tools and hoses.
- Gardens are to be cleaned up and vacated by Nov 1 (excludes year round spaces). Remove all stakes, mesh, poles, wood, string, hoses, tools, etc. Please break down and leave all organic plant material.
- The use of sterilants and herbicides are prohibited.
- Use of household pesticide is allowed, but you are encouraged to coordinate with the neighboring gardeners and be cautious and respectful of organic gardeners.
- Children are wonderful gardeners, but need to be under adult supervision.
- In order to conserve water, gardeners must be present when watering their gardens and irrigation may not be left unattended.
- Pets are allowed in the garden, but must be on a leash, picked up after, and kept out of all gardens other than your own.
- Discourage theft by harvesting promptly and please don't pick from other's gardens.
- No illegal plants may be grown, including plants on the Washington State Weed Control or Cowlitz County list of noxious weeds.
- The City of Longview is not responsible for any loss or damage to crops, equipment, or material.
- Gardeners failing to follow rules, regulations, maintain their space and keep weed free may lose their privileges to use garden space(s) for remainder of the season and following years.
- In order to discourage absentee gardeners, renters must begin working their sites by June 1st or forfeit their space.
- Your vehicle is to be parked along the edge of your space, not in the roadway.
